MAGIC LANTERN SOCIETY PRESENTATION VIDEOS

Over the years we have been video recording many of our meetings. Some of these have been made available on DVDs but recently we have been putting many on YouTube via our own channel called The Magic Lantern Society. If you search directly on YouTube you will probably not find us because we have made the videos available for 'Members Only' as a benefit of membership.

To find the videos, go to the Magic Lantern Society website and log in as a member via the 'Members' Area' link at the top of every page. You should see something like image (a). Now click on the 'Past events' button about half way down the left hand side and that should take you to a



form, as shown in image (b). Most of the videos available are from 2018 so if you select '2018' from the drop-down list in the 'Year of event' box and then click on the 'Search' button at the bottom you will be taken to a list of MLS events. Scroll down the page and you will see that every item available as a video is marked with a white arrow in a red button (see image (c)). Click on a red button to relive a magic moment of your choice.
