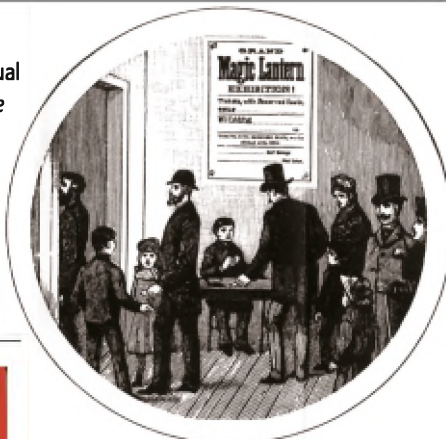

## NEW BOOK FROM DEAC ROSSELL

*Chronology of the Birth of Cinema 1833-1896* by MLS member Deac Rossell was published in October. Starting on 20 January 1833 it follows the international development of moving pictures, date by date, with devices such as the phenakistiscope (on the cover) appearing in the early pages. Each development is well illustrated – by photographs of the inventor, diagrams of the devices and other related

ephemera. The book is published by John Libbey Publishing, New Barnet, UK, and distributed by Indiana University Press (ISBN 086196716 2).
